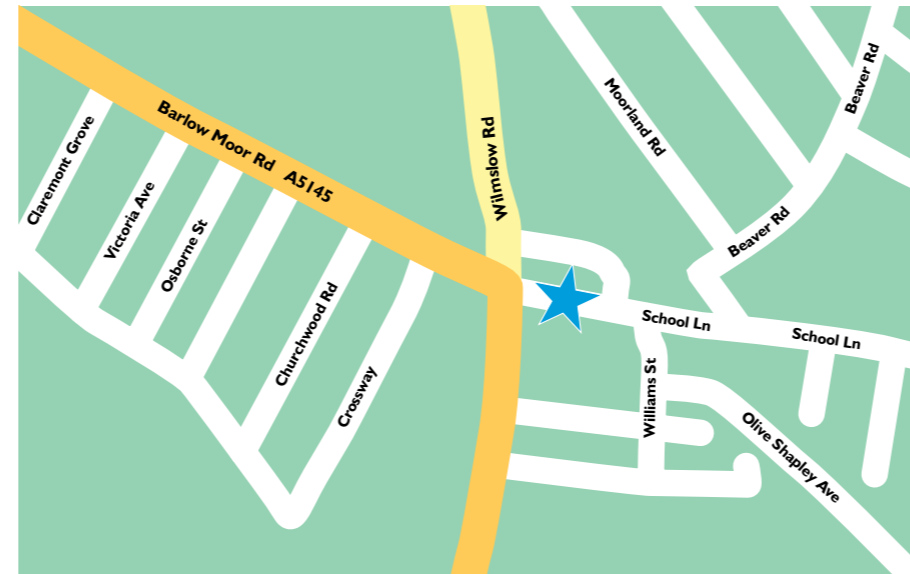

Types of treatment

We offer all types of routine dental care including preventative and periodontology (gum tissue health).

We provide enhanced aesthetic treatments including tooth whitening and white fillings. We also provide composite or ceramic veneers, high strength ceramic crowns and bridges, which not only look more lifelike, but are also biocompatible in the longer term. We can also offer dental referrals where necessary.

Appointment booking

Appointments can be made at reception. Once a patient, if you provide us with an email address or a mobile phone number, we will send you a reminder two days before your next appointment.

How do I register?

Your diagnostic consultation with a dentist at the practice will be a 14-point oral health check, which includes a full mouth and gum examination and oral health screening, including all soft tissues within the mouth. Up to two radiographs will be included in the charge, with an additional cost for further radiographs where necessary. We also offer a free consultation with one of our care co-ordinators.

A deposit is required at the time of booking for the diagnostic appointment. This can be taken over the phone with a debit or credit card.

Emergency treatment

We will endeavour to make every effort to see our patients on the same day, where dental emergency necessitates this. Non-registered patients may also be seen, where an appointment is available.

It is important in both cases that the practice is contacted as early in the day as possible. For emergencies out of normal practice hours, the practice can be contacted by phoning 0161 445 5459 where details of the dentist on-call will be given. You will be able to discuss your dental emergency with a dentist where advice will be provided. Where an emergency necessitates out of hours care, the on-call dentist will see you at the practice. Details of fees charged for this will be advised.

Patient confidentiality and safety

You will be asked to fill in and sign a full medical questionnaire. Please bring details of any current medication with you. It is important on subsequent visits that you inform us of any changes in your health or medication.

The practice complies with all current sterilisation and cross-infection control procedures.

Payment schemes

After your initial consultation, treatment is paid for on a fee-per-item basis. You will be required to pay for each item of treatment received on that day.

On completion of your treatment, we can register you on to one of our monthly payment membership plans. As a member, for a small monthly payment you will receive regular check-up and clean appointments per year as well as any emergency treatment during normal working hours (not including any permanent treatment). There are many other benefits on joining the plans, details of which will be found in the enclosed brochure.

Dr Owen also offers ongoing routine care under Denplan which is a capitation scheme. Details of this can also be found in a separate brochure.
